Mary Ann Robinson has been a member for over 20 years. She tells us "I am planning to have just over 20 varieties of tomato, most heritage, but a couple of hybrid from my choices, some parsley and perhaps parcel (a seldom available celery flavoured herb). Also a few walking stick cabbages (Jersey cabbage) and a few cup and saucer vines, Cobea scandens (Ornamental annuals, started early), 3 paper bark maples, a seedling Japanese maple, and a few small rock garden hardies dug from my garden such as Alchemilla erythropoda and polygala. At least that's the plan, provided the squirrels keep off."
