FILLING AND DISTRIBUTING ORDERS

Orders are filled on a “first-come, first-served” basis with donors’ orders filled before non-donors’. Due to continuing concern about respiratory illnesses, we are packaging with some individual members as we have for several years. By the end of December, after ordering is completed, the volunteers will be collecting the seeds from 2 central locations and packaging at home rather than in groups. A week later, they will return the completed packaging to the 2 central locations.

We will be trying our best to have seed ready for people to pick up their seeds at our January meeting

ORDERING FROM THE SEEDEX

We try to list seeds under the current name, correctly spelled. Parent plants are listed but their offspring may differ so be prepared for delightful surprises. All wild collected listings are identified by an * after the species name. Generally, colours are abbreviated to the first three or four letters. The height of each plant is given in cm but the numbers are often rounded off. The first two letters of the plant type are used as follows. AN: annual, BI: biennial, PE: perennial, BU: bulb, SH: shrub, TR: tree, VI: vine.

The cost is \$15.00 for each order which can include up to 60 packages of seed. Other people in a household who have been identified as ORG&HPS members may each place one additional order. These orders also cost \$15 each. No duplicates or ranges of numbers.

ONLINE:

You can submit your Seedex order online, and make payment by credit card or e-transfer (the “offline” option). Full instructions can be found [here](#) .

E-transfers should be sent to treasurer@onrockgarden.com . No password is required.

BY MAIL, INCLUDING ALL ORDERS PAID BY CHEQUE:

If you prefer to pay by cheque, it must be accompanied by a completed order form and mailed to Sherill Allard. Cheques should be made payable to “ORG&HPS”. Use the included order form or download one from the website.

We do not accept orders by email.

ORDERS FOR U.S.A.

Residents of the USA should order only seeds approved for entry into the USA. Those plants which are restricted have the symbol [X] in the germination code. If you order any of these, we can not send them. A Small Lots of Seed Permit is required and must be sent in with your order, along with the Conditions, an itemized list of the seed names, your own mailing label and the yellow and green mailing label. If you have recently applied for the permit, and expect it soon you can send it later on. You are only allowed 50 packets of seed, but if you fill in all 60 spaces, we'll stop when we get to 50 if you were lucky enough to get all your wishes!

ORDERS FOR COUNTRIES OTHER THAN CANADA AND U.S.A.

Check your country’s regulations and do not place an order if a phytosanitary certificate is required for importing seeds. We are unable to provide the certificate.

SYMBOLS

* This species needs special care which is described on the reverse.

? We have no information on this species. We sometimes provide an informed guess about which approach you should try.

! Sow immediately. Either the viability of these seeds is short or the species propagates best with fresh seed. Stored seed might be coaxed into germination with temperature cycling and patience.

[X] This seed is restricted and cannot be imported to the United States.

LETTERS

A Sow @ 20°C. Seed germinates within 3 months.

B Sow @ 20°C. If seed does not germinate within 3 months, try 4°C for 1-2 months, then 20°C again.

C Sow @ 20°C for 3 months, then place @ 4°C for 3 months.

D Use repeated cycles of 20°C, then 4°C for 3 months each. Germination is very prolonged.

E Sow @ 20°C for 6 weeks, then place @ 4°C for 6 weeks, then slowly raise temperature to 10°C for 6 weeks. If there is no germination, repeat the cycle.

F Sow @ 4°C.

G Sow @ 4°C for 3 months, then place @ 20°C for 3 months.

H Use repeated cycles of 4°C, then 20°C for 3 months each. Germination is very prolonged.

J Sow @ 4°C for 3 weeks, then place @ 20°C.

K Sow @ 10°C.

L Expose to fluctuating outdoor winter temperatures including freezing for 3 months. Gradually increase light and temperature in spring.

N Sow directly in garden.

NUMBERS

1 Resents transplanting.

2 Requires darkness.

3 Requires light or the seed is very fine. Surface sow and expose to light.

4 Germination is assisted by GA3.

5 Germination is successful only when GA3 is used.

6 Requires scarification. Nick or rub between sheets of sandpaper.

7 Requires soaking. Place in warm water until seeds swell, usually 24-48 hours. Discard water and any seeds that remain floating.

8 Pulpy coat inhibits germination. Remove by soaking and rinsing in clean water for approximately 7 days. Discard water.

9 At one time, we advised "Tails may inhibit germination. Remove them." The advice applied primarily to Pulsatillas and Clematis. Our most recent data indicates that leaving the tails on has no effect on germination.

WHAT OUR TEMPERATURE DESIGNATIONS MEAN

4°C Either place seeds outdoors to be exposed to a wide range of winter temperatures including freezing or put them in a refrigerator (not a deep freezer).

10°C Either place seeds outdoors in spring or fall or choose a very cool indoor location.

20°C Either place seeds in a sheltered outdoor location in mid to late spring or grow at room temperature.
